

Catch Up Funding 2013/2014

The school received £9,000 in funding for Year 7 catch up in the school year 2013/2014.

Achievement:

The funding was used to increase Teaching Assistant levels to support the teaching & learning of Y7 pupils.

As a result of this funding and other provisions offered by the school 94.1% of the cohort achieved comparative progress in reading.

Catch Up Funding 2014/2015

The school received £11,000 in funding for Year 7 catch up in the school year 2014/2015.

Planned expenditure:

As the school embeds previous practice within the school day it is looking to focus on facilitating Teaching Assistants to primarily support the teaching & learning of pupils by funding a Welfare Assistant post.

There is a continued focus on developing the roles of support staff to further improve the outcomes for pupils.

Catch Up Funding 2015/2016

The school expects to receive £8,000 in funding for Year 7 catch up in the school year 2015/2016. There are no pupils at the beginning of Year 7 expected to have achieved Level 4 in maths and/or English.

Planned expenditure:

To increase access to technology to further develop numeracy and literacy skills.

To purchase literacy and numeracy resources to extend learning opportunities and raise achievement.
